Lando Alliance is a U.S. 501(c)(3) nonprofit that maintains free and open-source developer tools and learning resources for modern web development. Our work centers on Lando, a cross-platform development and DevOps tool, plus docs, examples, events, and support channels that help people build and contribute.

Lando Alliance uses board-led governance, regular meetings, and durable records to keep stewardship accountable.

- Board composition [9]: At least three directors.
 - Regular meetings [10]: Mission, operations, and stewardship.
 - Auditable records [11]: Minutes, recordings, and core records.
